PRAYER FOR RELIEF:


WHEREFORE, in each of the aforesaid counts, Plaintiffs pray
this Honorable Court will:

- a. Order Judgment of \$612,463.00 (six hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count I.
- b. Order Judgment of \$75,000.01 (seventy-five thousand dollars and one cent) for Count II.
- c. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count III.
- d. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count IV.
- e. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count V.
- f. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count VI.
- g. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count VII.
- h. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count VIII.
- i. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count IX.
- j. Order Judgment of \$124,926.00 (one hundred twenty-four thousand, nine hundred twenty-six dollars) for Count X.
- k. Order Judgment of \$300,000.00 (three hundred thousand dollars) for Count XI.
- l. Order Judgment of \$300,000.00 (three hundred thousand dollars) for Count XII.

- m. Order Judgment of \$112,463.00 (one hundred twelve thousand, four hundred sixty-three dollars) for Count XIII.
- n. Issue a Judgment declaring Defendants have misapplied National Development Company, Inc.'s Trust Indenture by depriving Plaintiffs of their property.
- o. Issue a Judgment declaring the deprivation of Plaintiffs' property is so wrongful, arbitrary, capricious and without force and effect, thereby enjoining Defendants from depriving property owners of their property ever again.
- p. A Judgment declaring that Defendants have unjustly benefited from their contractual agreement with Plaintiffs by denying Plaintiffs use of their property and the other amenities and privileges afforded to Plaintiffs, as contained in the "Trust Indentures."
- q. A Judgment declaring the current "Amended Trust Indenture" is fraudulent, unconstitutional and unenforceable, with a new "Trust Indenture" to be drafted which is in the spirit of the original "Trust Indenture" to be ratified by the Woodland Lakes property owners.
- r. Punitive damages, to ensure Defendants will not continue with their practice of locking property owners out of Woodland Lakes, and/or coercive illegal activities.
- s. Grant such other and further relief that this Honorable Court may deem appropriate and just.
